Tribal Welfare Department – Establishment of Integrated Tribal Development Agency for Development of Scheduled Tribes in plain areas – Administrative Sanction – Accorded - Orders – Issued.

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ORDER:

In reference 1st read above, the Director of Tribal Welfare, Hyderabad has furnished proposal for creation of an agency in the name of ITDA for STs in plain areas with head quarters at Hyderabad to which will be registered under Societies Act. In this connection, he has suggested that;

- i) The jurisdiction of the ITDA subject to the exclusion of areas included in ITDAs Chenchus at Srisailam and Yanadies at Nellore shall extend to the districts of Krishna, Guntur, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur, Kurnool, Mahabubnagar, Hyderabad, Rangareddy, Medak, Karimangar, Nizamabad and Nalgonda.
- ii) The mandate of the ITDA shall be formulating appropriate plans for overall and integrated development of STs living in plain areas (other than Yanadies and Chenchus), coordinating with lines departments, district administration of the respective districts for implementation of various developmental and welfare programs intended for STs and monitoring implementation of TSP of line departments in Non-ITDA districts.
- iii) The ITDA will have a Governing Body under the Chairmanship of Director Tribal Welfare with HODs of key departments such as agriculture, horticulture, minor irrigation, weaker sections housing, primary education, health etc., as Members.
- iv) To post a senior time scale IAS Officer as Project Officer and Member Convenor for the ITDA.,
- v) The ITDA will have sectoral officers and office staff.
- vi) To create a separate head of account for meeting the recurring and the non-recurring expenditure of the ITDA under "2225-Welfare of SCs, STs and OBCs-02 Welfare of STs-MH 102 Economic Development -GH 11 Normal State Plan -SH (07) Development of Sts in plain areas -310 -GIA".
- vii) A personal deposit account (PD Account) may be permitted to be opened to deposit the funds. Project Officer for STs in Plain areas may be permitted to operate the Personal Deposit Account.
- viii) An amount of Rs.2.00 crores may be allotted in 2008 09 budget (Rs.0.50 crores may be allotted initially towards grant-in-aid for salaries and Rs.1.50 crores for other grants-in-aid.

- ix) The line departments shall formulate the TSP of the Non-ITDA districts in consultation with the Project Officer, ITDA and the TSP shall have to be approved by the Governing Body.
- x) To create the following posts, subject to filling up of these posts on deputation basis with their own scale of pay and subject to without resorting additional funds:-

Project Officer - 01
 Assistant Project Officer - 06
 Administrative Officer - 01
 Accounts Officer - 01
 Office Superintendents - 03
 Senor Assistants - 03

xi) To accord permission for the following posts to outsource the services through an agency by following guidelines on outsourcing:-

1. Junior Assistants - 03
2. Data Processing Officer - 01
3. Data Entry Operators - 03
4. Class-IV - 05

- 2. Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Tribal Welfare hereby accord administrative sanction for constitution of an ITDA for development of STs in plain areas and issue the following orders;
 - i) An agency in the name of ITDA for STs in plain areas is sanctioned with head quarters at Hyderabad and it be registered under Societies Act.
 - ii) The jurisdiction of the ITDA subject to the exclusion of areas included in ITDAs Chenchus at Srisailam and Yanadies at Nellore shall extend to the districts of Krishna, Guntur, Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur, Kurnool, Mahabubnagar, Hyderabad, Rangareddy, Medak, Karimangar, Nizamabad and Nalgonda.
 - iii) The mandate of the ITDA shall be formulating appropriate plans for overall and integrated development of STs living in plain areas (other than Yanadies and Chenchus), coordinating with lines departments, district administration of the respective districts for implementation of various developmental and welfare programs intended for STs and monitoring implementation of TSP of line departments in Non-ITDA districts.
 - iv) The ITDA shall have a Governing Body under the Chairmanship of Director Tribal Welfare with HODs of key departments such as agriculture, horticulture, minor irrigation, weaker sections housing, primary education, health etc., as Members.
 - v) The ITDA shall have a Project Officer as its Member-convener with cadre post and a senior time scale IAS Officer be posted as Project Officer.
 - vi)The ITDA shall have sectoral officers and office staff orders sanctioning the staff will be issued separately.

- vii) A separate head of account be opened for meeting the recurring and the non-recurring expenditure of the ITDA under "2225-Welfare of SCs, STs and OBCs-02 Welfare of STs-MH 102 Economic Development -GH 11 Normal State Plan -SH (07) Development of Sts in plain areas -310 -GIA"
- viii) Permission is accorded to open a personal deposit account (PD Account) to deposit the funds. Project Officer for STs in Plain areas permitted to operate the Personal Deposit Account.
- ix) An amount of Rs.2.00 crores allotted in 2008 09 budget (Rs.0.50 crores allotted initially towards grant-in-aid for salaries and Rs.1.50 crores for other grants-in-aid and
- x) The line departments shall formulate the TSP of the Non-ITDA districts in consultation with the Project Officer, ITDA and the TSP shall have to be approved by the Governing Body.
- 3. The Director of Tribal Welfare, Hyderabad shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
- 4. This orders issued with the concurrence of Finance (SMPC) Department vide their U.O.No.6158/A/388/A3/SMPC/2009, dated 27-02-2009.
